



ARMED ROBBERIES and WORKPLACE VIOLENCE INFORMATION SESSION

PANL is pleased to partner with the Newfoundland and Labrador Pharmacy Board, the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, and WorkplaceNL for an information session on June 20.

Constable Steve Curnew of the RNC will provide pharmacists and pharmacy owners with information on what to do if being robbed, protocols to follow after a robbery and practices that pharmacies should follow to help prevent being a victim of a robbery. The RNC will also discuss some new technology available that is currently being used by pharmacies in British Columbia and Ontario.

Joanne Cuff, Health and Safety Advisor, Prevention Services with WorkplaceNL will present on the legislative responsibility of employers in ensuring the health and safety of their workers, conducting hazard/risk assessments, mitigating risks of working alone, and implementing change to prevent workplace violence.
