NOMINATION PROCESS

1. The completed Nomination form must be received by the Executive Director at 83 Thorburn Road, Suite 203, St. John's, NL by 4:00 PM on or before Friday, May 10, 2019.
2. Nominations must be signed by at least two (2) nominators with the signed consent of the nominee. The nominee and all nominators must practice in the Zone or Category for which the nomination is being made with the exception of the New Practitioner which may be nominated by any regular member.
3. The Nominee and all nominators must be "regular" members licensed to practice in pharmacy in Newfoundland and Labrador.

Term of Office:

Board members shall be elected for a two-year term of office or in the case of Special Nominations, for the remainder of the term.

Zone 1 (Eastern Zone) – Two (2) Regular Nominations

Avalon Peninsula and all the Burin Peninsula up to and including Goobies and East.

Zone 3 (Western Zone) – Two (2) Regular Nominations

West of Grand Falls-Windsor, including the Baie Verte Peninsula, White Bay, the Northern Peninsula, Labrador, the west coast extending to Port-aux-Basques and that part of the south coast that includes Burgeo and Ramea.

Zone 4 (Hospital Zone) – Two (2) Regular Nominations

A Hospital Pharmacist is defined as a pharmacist who is registered as per their primary occupation in a hospital or related institution of Newfoundland and Labrador.

New Practitioner – One (1) Regular Nomination

New practitioner not practicing more than five (5) years regardless of Zone.
