

Injection Standard of Practice: CPR/First Aid Requirement

PANL has received a few inquiries related to the CPR/First Aid requirement noted in the [Standards for the Safe and Effective Administration of Drug Therapy by Inhalation or Injection](#) .

Some providers, as they did last year, may be extending the expiry dates on first aid/CPR certificates in lieu of being able to currently offer in-person programs.

The NLPB has advised that there may be situations the Board could look at on a case-by-case basis – for example, if a pharmacist is already authorized and their certification has expired versus a pharmacist who has never completed CPR/first aid or never been authorized.
